Paul E. Tedford, 76, of Kankakee, died Thursday (May 28, 2009) at Provena Our Lady of Victory. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. Wednesday until the 7 p.m. funeral service at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. Burial will be held at 1 p.m. Thursday at Ten Mile Cemetery in McLeansboro. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley. Mr. Tedford was a retired pharmacy tech from Jaffee Drug Stores after 36 years and Manteno State Hospital after 16 years.
