Memorial visitation for Paul A. Trepanier Sr., 92, of Kankakee, will be from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. Friday, Jan. 10, at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. He passed away Dec. 29, 2013, at his home. Mr. Trepanier worked at A.O. Smith Corp. as an inspector for more than 40 years, retiring in 1985. He was born Oct. 22, 1921, in Kankakee, the son of Joseph and Fern Bouchard Trepanier. His wife, the former Dorothy Coash, whom he married Jan. 31, 1942, at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, died Jan. 25, 1985. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army 105th Combat Engineers 30th Infantry division during World War II. They landed on Omaha Beach on Aug. 6, 1944.
