Paula Marie McCullough, 56, of Somonauk, passed away July 17, 2014 at her home.

She was born Sept. 2, 1957 at Watseka Memorial Hospital.

Paula is survived by her mother, Norma Lucile McCullough, of Watseka; two brothers, Scott McCullough, of Watseka, and Reed (Lisa) McCullough, of Manteno; and two nephews, Dayton McCullough, of Watseka, and Cody McCullough, of Manteno.

Paula was preceded in death by her father, Thomas Gerald McCullough, of Watseka.

Paula graduated from Watseka High School in 1975 and then attended Eastern Illinois University in Charleston from 1975 to 1979, graduating with two majors, finance and pre-law. She continued her education by getting her registered nursing degree from Governors State University in University Park and this became the basis of her life's career for almost the next three decades.

Paula worked her way up to become the director of nursing at two different nursing homes. She landed her dream job with Wellness Incorporated in

Aurora, one of the largest health-screening companies in the U.S. She loved the company motto: "We believe in the power of good health." She traveled around the U.S. as a screening director for the remainder of her career. She managed a team of nurses who performed health screenings for some of the largest to the smallest companies, organization and municipalities. She loved traveling here and abroad, especially Italy. She never saw a craft fair she didn't support.

Although Paula hadn't lived in Watseka for many years, she still had ties to local businesses as an owner/shareholder in McCullough Imp. Co. and in the Lawrence McCullough Corporation.

There is no public visitation or funeral scheduled per her request.
