Peter William Bullock, 83, of Kankakee, died after an extended illness Thursday (July 14, 2005) at his residence in Miller Center. A memorial visitation will be held 2-5 p.m. Sunday, July 24 at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. Cremation rites have been accorded by the Cremation Society of Illinois. Interment will be at Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery in Elwood. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley. Mr. Bullock was born July 15, 1921, in Chicago, to William and Anna Hansen Bullock. After graduating from trade school, he joined the U.S. Marine Corps and served in the South Pacific during World War II. His hobbies included painting, sculpting, traveling and gardening. He lived most of his life in Libertyville. Surviving are two sons and daughters-in-law, Peter Y.
