Quida E. Pribyl III, 77, of Grant Park passed away Saturday (Sept. 12, 2015) at his home.

He was born April 23, 1938, in Chicago, the son of Quida Pribyl II and Henrietta Materna Pribyl. He married Janice L. Curulewski on Jan. 23, 1960. She preceded him in death on Sept. 1, 2015.

Mr. Pribyl retired from Ford Motor Company after 35 years of service.

He was a veteran of the U.S. Navy. His hobbies included fishing and woodworking.

we are preparing a publication about Alois Kares, the founder of a famous transport company Kares & Stocky in Bremen. Alois Kares was probably the first professional emigrant agent, originally from Czechia, who transported his compatriots to America.

One of his daughters (Sofie, 1842 – 1892) married with Frank G. Pribyl (14.10.1836 in Nachod/Czechia † 24.2.1902 in Houston/Texas), the other of his daughters (Anna, 1847 – 1869) married with Quida E. Pribyl's great-grandfather John M. Pribyl (* 16.6.1839 in Kunstat/Czechia † August 1915 in Chicago). His second wife Marie J. Pribyl nee Vesely (* 14.9.1850 in Podoli I/Czechia † 8.10.1938 in Chicago) was Quida E.
