He served in the U.S. Army. He enjoyed spending time with family. He helped raise his granddaughter, Melissa. He liked bowling, big-band music and was passionate about reading, especially later in his life.

Surviving are two daughters and sons-in-law, RaeLene and Michael Bass, of Bourbonnais, Lori and John Baron, of Plainfield; five grandchildren, Joshua Jackson, Mallory Bass, Melissa, Matthew and Samantha Baron; and one sister, Nina Mick.
