Raymond D. Audette, 91, of Bradley, died Saturday (Oct. 29, 2011) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee. Visitation will be from 9 a.m. to 10:45 a.m. Wednesday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will follow at 11 a.m. at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley, where he was a member.
