Raymond Denoyer -- St. Anne Raymond Arthur Denoyer, 88, of St. Anne, died Tuesday (Oct. 21, 2008) at his home. Visitation will be from 3 p.m. Thursday until the 7 p.m. services at the Clancy-Gernon-Houk Funeral Home in St. Anne. Memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley or for Masses. Mr. Denoyer had worked at St. Anne Drainage for 26 years, Roper Corporation, Bradley Division for 18 years, and had been the caretaker at St. Anne Cemetery for 12 years. He was born Dec. 11, 1919, in St. Anne, the son of Edward and Elsie Nourie Denoyer. His wife, the former Vivian Williamson, whom he married June 21, 1941, in Kankakee, died July 30, 2003. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army serving during World War II and commander of St. Anne American Legion Post 842 for 62 years. He was a member of St. Anne Catholic Church. He loved gardening and was an overall Mr. Fix-It. Surviving are one son and daughter-in-law, Raymond and Judy Denoyer of Bradley; one daughter and son-in-law, Lana and Michael White of St. Anne; seven grandchildren, 10 great-grandchildren, and two stepgrandchildren; one sister, Eleanor Casper of Bradley; two brothers and one sister-in-law, Lawrence and Jan Denoyer of Bradley, Albert Denoyer of Blue Island; and several nieces and nephews. Deceased are three brothers and two sisters.
