Richard Doud -- Kankakee Richard D. Doud, 92, of Kankakee, died Saturday (Aug. 25, 2007) at Riverside Medical Center. Cremation rites have been accorded. A gathering of neighbors, friends and family will be held from 6 p.m. Tuesday until the 7:30 p.m. services at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. Mr. Doud retired at age 62 from Kroehler Manufacturing where he was a truck driver. He went back to work for his own company and then later for Midwest Bus as a driver. He retired for a second time at age 82. He was born Jan. 26, 1915, in Kouts, Ind., the son of Presdy and Mary Alice Edwards Doud. His wife, the former Delores E. Leonard, whom he married July 17, 1938, in Kankakee, died Aug. 16, 2006. He was a 1st lieutenant, serving in the U.S. Army, 7th Cavalry, in combat during World War II.
