Visitation for Richard "Rick" A. Haynes, 51, of Bourbonnais, will be from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. Wednesday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Thursday at Maternity BVM Catholic Church, Bourbonnais, where he was a member. The Rev. Richard Pighini will officiate. Cremation rites will be accorded following the funeral Mass. Inurnment in All Saints Cemetery, Bourbonnais, will be at a later date. Memorials may be made to Maternity BVM Catholic Church or to the family wishes. He died Sunday (Aug. 16, 2009) in the emergency room at Provena St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee. Mr. Haynes was co-owner/contractor of Haynes Construction. He was born Aug. 22, 1957, in Kankakee, the son of Richard P. and Mary L. Wheeler Haynes. He was a 1975 graduate of Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School, where he played football. He was a member of the Professional Roofing Advisory Council for Chicagoland. He enjoyed watching old movies, exercising, deep-sea fishing and going to area festivals. Surviving are his mother of Bourbonnais; two sisters and one brother-in-law, Kimberly Stam of Joliet, Karen and Steve Brown of Rio Rancho, N.M.; three brothers and one sister-in-law, Doug Haynes of Bourbonnais, Todd and Laurie Haynes of Bloomington, Eric Haynes of Bourbonnais; and several nieces and nephews. His father is deceased.
