He died Monday (Dec. 10, 2007) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital. Mr. Regnier was the retired owner and operator of General Oil and Equipment Co. in Kankakee. He was born Aug. 3, 1938, in Kankakee, the son of Armel "Shorty" and Frances Tyrrell Regnier. He was a graduate of Kankakee High School and Eastern Illinois University. He served in the National Guard. He was one of the founders of Kankakee Community College Cavalier Club. He was a member and former board member of the Kankakee Country Club, and a member of the Knights of Columbus and the Elks. He enjoyed golfing. Surviving are his wife, the former Sandra Krecioch, whom he married May 3, 1969, at St. Teresa Catholic Church in Kankakee; one son and daughter-in-law, David and Allyson Regnier of Chicago; one granddaughter, Emma; and one brother, Terry Regnier of Plantation, Fla. His parents are deceased.
