Richard D. "Rich" Regnier, 66, of St. Anne, passed away April 1 at Hines VA Hospital.

He was born Feb. 20, 1949, in Kankakee, the son of Donald and Inez Arseneau Regnier. Rich married Connie Hebert in 1971, at the St. Anne Catholic Church.

He was the owner of Regnier Remodeling. Rich was a loving, kind, and gentle husband, father, grandfather, brother and son. He was a member of St. Anne Catholic Church and St. Anne Knights of Columbus. Rich was also a member of the St. Anne Park Community serving the youth of St. Anne, a Little League coach for 20 years, and was generous and devoted to his church and his community.

Mr. Regnier was a veteran of the U.S. Army, serving during the Vietnam War with the 101st Airborne.
