We as a family along with your family, had some wonderful times!

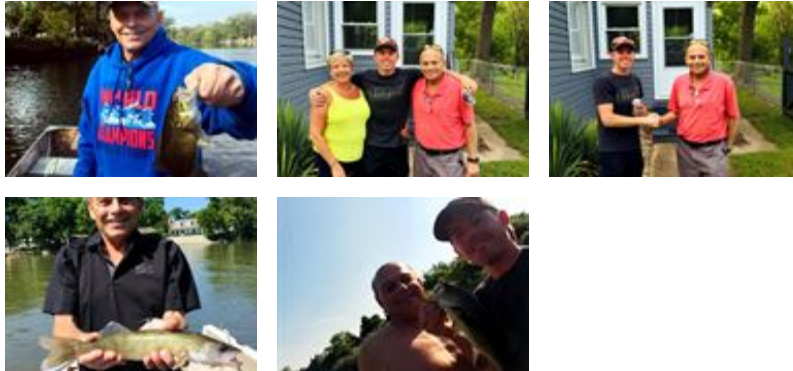
