December 8, 1945 - July 25, 2015

Dr. Richard J. Wegner PhD., 69, of Davenport, Fla., and formerly of Kankakee, passed away Saturday (July 25, 2015) in Kankakee.

He was born Dec. 8, 1945, in Kankakee, the son of Joseph C. and Norma Bleau Wegner. He married Jeannine V. Rewerts at the Moose in Bradley.

Richard loved his family more than anything. He played in a band called Art and Changing Tides as the drummer. He loved to paint and sing old songs to his wife on their road trips. He was a Cubs and Bears fan. He loved fishing with Jeff, Ryan and Ronnie. He was a man of many trades and helped and mentored everyone.

He served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War, was a Republican, believed in the 2nd Amendment, was of the Catholic faith and proud to be an organ donor.

He was a psychologist at Stateville Prison, Tinley Park Mental Hospital and a family counselor at Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee. He also worked at Lowe's in the plumbing department.

Survivors include his wife, of Davenport, Fla.; three daughters, Rene' Wegner, of Chicago, Ande' Wegner, of Bourbonnais, and Cecilia "CeCe" (Larry) Davis,

of Austin, Texas; two stepchildren, Nathan (Amy) Kroll, of St. Anne, and Megan Kroll, of Bradley; sister, Lynn (Larry) Bertrand, of Crossville, Tenn.; brothers, Van (Kay) Wegner, of Kankakee, Mark (Michele) Wegner, of Davenport, Fla., Tim (Lana) Wegner, of Osceola, Mo.; and five grandchildren, Lennon, LJ, Dylan, Kennedy and Keegan.

Preceding him in death were his parents; one brother; and one sister.
