



Richard "Biss" Bisailon

July 30, 1929 - November 11, 2011

Richard S. "Biss" Bisailon, 82, of Bourbonnais, died Friday (Nov. 11, 2011) at Provena Heritage Village in Kankakee. Visitation will be from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. Monday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. The funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11

a.m. Tuesday at Maternity BVM Catholic Church in Bourbonnais. Interment will be in All Saints Cemetery in Bourbonnais. Memorials may be made in his name to Maternity BVM Catholic School or for Masses. Mr. Bisailon retired from Akzo Nobel Inc. in Chicago.

He was born July 30, 1929, in Bourbonnais, the son of Adelard and Desneiges (Faford) Bisailon. He was a graduate of St. Patrick High School in Kankakee, and attended

DePaul University in Chicago. He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean conflict. He volunteered at Riverside Medical Center and Provena St. Mary's Hospital, and he delivered Meals on Wheels. He is survived by his wife, the former Mary A. Arseneau, whom he married May 23, 1953, at Maternity BVM Catholic Church; one daughter and son-in-law, Michelle and John Baldwin, of Orland Park; one granddaughter, Toni (Chris) Adams; one great-grandson, Johnny Adams; and one sister, Marguerite Schuh, of Bourbonnais. He was preceded in death by his parents; and four brothers, Gerard, Robert, Paul and Thomas.
