Rita Regnier -- Kankakee Visitation for Rita N. Regnier, 83, of Kankakee, will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, and from 10:30 a.m. Monday at St. Patrick's Catholic Church, until the 11 a.m. celebration of the funeral Mass. Cremation rites were accorded by Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Crematory. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to St. Patrick's Catholic Church, where she was a member. She died Wednesday (Feb. 27, 2008) at the Miller Center. Mrs. Regnier was a retired secretary from the architectural firm of Moline and Seaton. She had also worked for the R.M. Kerst Insurance Agency and the Kankakee Chamber of Commerce, where she was secretary to Ron Henrekin, director of the Chamber, for five years. She was born Jan. 10, 1925, in Odell, the daughter of Leo G. and Edith Franey Noonan. Her husband, Orville "Pete" Regnier, whom she married July 5, 1947, at St. Patrick's Catholic Church, died Jan. 19, 1976. She graduated from St. Paul School, Odell and Gallagher School of Business in Kankakee. She was a lifetime member of the Kankakee County Historical Society, where she volunteered as membership chairman. She also volunteered at Provena St. Mary's Hospital Auxiliary. She was a member of Epsilon Sigma Alpha Service Sorority. She enjoyed traveling and was able to trace her Irish roots in County Clare Ireland. She also enjoyed bridge and especially her family. Surviving are two daughters and sons-in-law, Jeanne and Ronald Levin of Carmel, Ind., Joan and Paul Germano of Kankakee; one son and daughter-in-law, James L. and Jan Regnier of St. Louis, Mo.; four

grandchildren, Kristin Levin Shuler, Elizabeth Regnier, Eleanor Germano, Sean Regnier; one great-granddaughter, Alexandra Shuler; one sister, Genevieve Trainor of Peoria; and two sisters-in-law, Daah Franey of Chatsworth, and Mary Jane Noonan of Arizona. Deceased are her parents and two brothers, Leo Noonan and Donald "Bud" Noonan.
