"Bob" Gohring, 87, of Bourbonnais, will be from 10 a.m. to 10:45 a.m. Wednesday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. He died Sunday (Jan. 21, 2007) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee, after a short illness. Mr. Gohring was retired from Roper Corp., Kankakee Div., and Hogard Business Services. He was born Dec. 10, 1919, in Sterling, the son of Edward and Nellie Grobe Gohring. He served in the U.S. Army for four years during World War II. He was a member of Maternity BVM Catholic Church and was a Fourth Degree in the Knights of Columbus. He volunteered many years at Provena St. Mary's Hospital. Surviving are his wife, the former Joan Kraus, whom he married Aug. 13, 1966, at St. Patrick's Catholic Church, Kankakee; and one niece and one nephew of Sterling. Deceased are one brother, Lloyd Gohring; and two sisters, Anna Anderson and Ruth Roth.
