Visitation for Robert L. Guimond, 80, of Bourbonnais, will be from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. Wednesday, Dec. 28, at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Thursday at Maternity BVM Catholic Church, Bourbonnais, where he was a member. Father Richard Pighini will officiate.

Burial will be in St. Patrick Catholic Cemetery, Momence. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to Maternity BVM Catholic Church or to Bishop McNamara Catholic High School. He died Monday (Dec. 19, 2011) at Riverside Medical Center, Kankakee.

Mr. Guimond worked for AT&T, retiring after 35 years of service. He also drove for area car dealerships. He was born May 24, 1931, in Kankakee, the son of Homer and Hattie Kerouac Guimond. Mr. Guimond and his wife, Marge, would have celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary Dec. 27. He was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force, serving in Korea. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus, the Moose, the Elks, the Bourbonnais VFW Post 9961 and the Telephone Pioneers. He enjoyed dancing, bowling, playing cards, and he especially enjoyed his family.

Surviving are his wife, the former Marjorie "Marge" E. Hebert, of Bourbonnais, whom he married Dec. 27, 1951, at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church,

Kankakee; two sons and daughters-in-law, Michael and Cindy Guimond, of Bradenton, Fla., and Brian and Paula Guimond, of St. Cloud, Minn.; four daughters and one son-in-law, Robbie Holz, of Edmonds, Wash., Paula Brown, of Champaign, Pamela and Tim West, of Bourbonnais, and Laurie Holderman, of Edmonds; 12 grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, grandparents and one sister, Florence O'Connor.
