Robert V. "Bob" Guimond, 84, of Bourbonnais, passed away Saturday (Aug. 10, 2013) at Presence St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Wednesday at Maternity BVM Catholic Church, Bourbonnais.
