He was a past Boy Scout/Webelos leader of Pack 319. He loved spending time with his family, especially the grandkids and great-grandkids. He enjoyed traveling, camping, snowmobiling,

flea marketing, farming with his brother, hunting and fishing. His "hobby" was watching, protecting and feeding the birds, squirrels and rabbits at home.

Surviving are his wife, the former Rose Styck, of St. Anne, whom he married Sept. 28, 1957, in Herscher; two sons, David Hines, of Bourbonnais, and Doug Hines, of St. Anne; one daughter and son-in-law, Lynne and Dale Papineau, of St. Anne; six grandchildren and three great-grandchildren; two brothers-in-law, Bruce (MaryAnn) Styck, and Hank (Wanda) Styck; two sisters-in-law, Linda Hines and Ruth Styck; and several nieces and nephews.
