



## Robert J. Hisel

June 6, 1930 - November 26, 2015

Robert J. Hisel, age 85, of Kankakee, died Thursday, November 26, 2015 at Presence St. Mary's Hospital. He was born June 6, 1930 in Kankakee, the son of Myron & Bessie McCracken Hisel.

He married Patricia Conway August 6, 1950 in Kankakee.

Robert was a retired draftsman at Roper Corporation, Bradley Division. Robert was very active in the Knights of Columbus at the local, state, and national levels. He was Past State Deputy for the Illinois State Council for the Knights of Columbus from 1976 to 1977, Past Supreme Director for nine years with the Supreme Council, Past Grand Knight of Council 745 in Kankakee where he was a long time member, and Robert was also a Long time member of 4th degree Assembly #202 Bishop McNamara.

He was also a local realtor. He was a parishioner at St. Teresa Catholic Church in Kankakee. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army serving during the Korean Conflict.

Surviving are his wife, Patricia Hisel of Kankakee; one son, John Hisel & Rob Kerr of Chicago; and one daughter Christine & Ted Meade of Kankakee.

He is preceded in death by his parents; 3 brothers, Delmar, Donald, and Harold; 3 sisters, Betty Tofte, Madora Menard, and Daleta Hisel.
