Robert Kring Sr. -- Bourbonnais Robert M. "Bob" Kring Sr., 56, of Bourbonnais, died Friday (Nov. 28, 2008) at his home. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Monday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais, and from 9:30 a.m. Tuesday at College Church of the Nazarene in Bourbonnais, until the 11 a.m. funeral service.
