Robert McClure, age 67, of Bradley passed at Saturday, December 2, 2017 at his home. He was born November 21, 1950 in Ft. Worth, Texas, the son of James W. & Dorothy Irene Marlar McClure. Robert married Conni D. Langlois on August 12, 1972. She preceded him in death on October 31, 2013.
