Robert J. "Bob" Mulcahy, 81, of Bourbonnais, died Thursday (July 30, 2009) at his home, following a sudden illness. Visitation will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Monday at St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church, Kankakee, where he was a member. The Rev. Dennis Settles will officiate. Inurnment will be in Mount Calvary Cemetery, Kankakee. Mr. Mulcahy was the founder of Kankakee Business Machines. He was born Aug. 27, 1927, the son of Bernard and Evelyn Mahoney Mulcahy. He was a veteran of the Army of the United States. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus and Aroma Park American Legion. He was past president of the Chicago Office Machines Dealer Association and a former member of the Elks. He was a former commissioner for the Kankakee County Housing Authority. 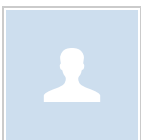
