Roberta A. Renville, age 77 of Bourbonnais passed away Tuesday, December 13, 2022, at Riverside Miller Healthcare, Kankakee. She was born on December 27, 1944, in Watseka, the daughter of Richard and Olive (Robbins) Burton. Roberta married Ronald Renville on July 17, 1965, at St. Patrick Catholic Church, Kankakee. He preceded her death on January 4, 2016. Roberta was an administrative assistant for the City of Kankakee Police and Fire Departments. She retired in 2000 after 28 years of employment. She was a member of the Kankakee Historical Society, Bourbonnais Historical Society and Kankakee Quiltmakers. Roberta is a member of the Laureate Beta Omega Chapter of the Beta Sigma Phi Sorority.
