Roberta Sue Bogardus, 62, of Kankakee, died Saturday (May 9, 2009) at Riverside Medical Center. Surviving are her husband, Richard Bogardus, of Kankakee, whom she married Aug. 18, 1968, in St. Francisville; one son and daughter-in-law, Andrew and Melissa Bogardus of Kissimmee, Fla.; two daughters and sons-in-law, Meredith and Jason Owens of Yorkville, Regan and Scott Kendregan of Bourbonnais; six grandchildren, Nick and Jacob Owens, Caleb and Aaron Kendregan, and Brayden and Logan Bogardus; her father of Vincennes; and several nieces and nephews. Deceased are her mother and one sister, who died at birth.
