Robin Hylbert -- Bourbonnais Robin D. Hylbert, 51, of Bourbonnais, died Monday (Nov. 14, 2005) after a sudden illness. Visitation will be from 3-8 p.m. Wednesday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. There will also be visitation from 10 - 11 AM before the services at the church. Services will be held at 11 a.m. Thursday at College Church of the Nazarene, where he was a member. Cremation rites will be accorded. Memorials may be made to the Salvation Army. Mr. Hylbert was the owner/operator of Culligan Water Conditioning in Chebanse. He was born Oct. 3, 1954, in Evanston, the son of Paul and Charlotte Johnson Hylbert. He coached ice hockey and was a longtime soccer coach for Bourbonnais Dynamo. He enjoyed biking. Surviving are his wife, the former Nancy Hawes, whom he married Feb. 14, 1976, in Northbrook; one son, Drew Hylbert of Stamford, Conn.; one daughter, Blair Hylbert of Bourbonnais; his parents of Savannah, Ga.; one sister and brother-in-law, Christine and Peter Dietze of Boulder, Colo.; and two brothers and one sister-in-law, Paul and Katharine Hylbert of Seattle, Wash. and Tony Hylbert of Madison, Wis.
