January 8, 1936 - March 13, 2009

Ronald D. Belluso, 73, of Bourbonnais, died Friday (March 13, 2009) at his home. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Monday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Tuesday at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, Kankakee, where he was a member. Burial will be in All Saints Cemetery, Bourbonnais. Memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley or to the American Cancer Society. Mr. Belluso was a retired locomotive engineer. He started working for the New York Central-Penn Central railroads which later became Conrail and was subsequently purchased by the CSX-Norfolk Southern railroads. He was born Jan. 8, 1936, in Kankakee, the son of Joseph I. and Annette R. Boucher Belluso. He was a graduate of St. Patrick High School. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus, the Elks, president of the Men's Senior Bowlers, and past president of the Illinois Left Handed Golfers. He enjoyed gardening. Surviving are his wife, the former Doris A. Smith, whom he married June 9, 1956, at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church; three sons and daughters-in-law, Michael P. and Yolanda Belluso of Kankakee, Joseph E. and Megan Belluso of Albany, N.Y., William A. and Athena Belluso of Bourbonnais; three daughters and two sons-in-law, Christine L. and Michael Duff of Indianapolis, Ind., Ann K. and Anthony Cravero of west Des Moines, Iowa, Rhonda K. Belluso of Washington D.C.; eight grandchildren and one great-grandchild; and three sisters and brothers-in-law, Barbara and John Lagacy of St. Anne, Sandra and Tom Terry of St. Paul, Minn., and Kathryn and Dave Langevin of

Palos Park. One brother, Michael J. Belluso, is deceased.
