Ronald H. Gravitt Jr., 43, of Momence, died Monday (July 5, 2010) at his home. Visitation will be from 2 p.m. Sunday until the 5 p.m. services at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. He received the Army Service Ribbon, the Overseas Service Ribbon, the Army Good Conduct Medal and the Army Achievement Medal with Four Bronze Oak Leaf Clusters. He attended Southern Illinois University. Surviving are his mother, Gladys Fowler of Kankakee; father and stepmother, Ronald H.
