Rosa Bulliner-Stone, 95, of Kankakee, died Monday (Oct. 17, 2011) at the Miller Center. Visitation will be from 5 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Friday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee.
