Rosalie E. Raines, 88, of Bourbonnais, passed away Saturday May 13, 2017 at home. She was born August 4, 1928 in Bourbonnais to Willard and Hattie (Raymond) Arseneau. Rosalie married Jack Raines on September 10, 1949 at Maternity BVM Catholic Church in Bourbonnais. He passed away on February 22, 2016.

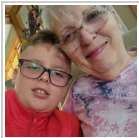
