“ My name is William Golding and I am an 86 year old cousin to Roselind & I live in Bourbonnais. Roselind's mother Cora Brown Hubert and my father's mother Netty Brown Golding were sisters. They also had another sister Rose Brown Beland with whom, as a young boy, spent several summers with on their various farms, near St. Anne. We visited with our relatives in and around St. Anne frequently back in those days. They seldom came to Kankakee, but we kept in touch by our periodic visits to that area.

Some years ago I met one of Gyle's daughters when Roselind lived on the corner house in St. Anne. I last saw Roselind when my wife Patricia, my sister (Patricia Golding Arseneau) & I visited her a few summers ago at the assisted living place near the Catholic church. Roselind had given me her telephone number one time when I saw her, but when I tried to call her several months ago, the phone had been disconnected and I had no way to learn of her whereabouts. I was fairly sure that she moved to be near her granddaughter who I know lived somewhere in Indiana.

I'm very sorry that I will be out of town on Tuesday and will miss being at the visitation and funeral. I extend my sympathies to her remaining family members and want them to know that one of the very few of her survivors will always remember the times I and my family spent with Roselind and the other St. Anne relatives.
