Roy L. White, 81, of Bourbonnais, died Wednesday (Nov. 3, 2010) at his home. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais, where services will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday. Deacon Patrick Skelly will officiate.
