Ruth Kirk, 92, of Bradley, died Saturday (July 2, 2011) at Riverside Medical Center, Kankakee. Visitation will be from 10 a.m. Wednesday until the noon funeral services at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. The Rev. Dan Taylor of Peoples Church and her grandson, the Rev. Brent Kirk, of Dresden, Ohio, will officiate. Burial will be in Mound Grove Gardens of Memory, Kankakee.
