Ruth M. Varness, 90, of Kankakee, died Friday (June 19, 2009) at Riverside Medical Center. Visitation will be from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. today at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, and from 10 a.m. Tuesday at St. Mark United Methodist Church, until the 11 a.m. services.
