



## Salvatore Sam Passentino

January 14, 1928 - November 24, 2014

Sam Passentino, 86, of Bradley, passed away Monday (Nov. 24, 2014) at Illinois Veterans Home in Manteno.

He was born Jan. 14, 1928, in Kankakee, the son of Giacinto and Lucia Bencivennie Passentino. He married Dorothy Damler (Fleming) on April 9, 1977, in Reno, Nev. She preceded him in death on Oct. 8, 2001.
