Sandi was a schoolteacher. She had taught at St. Anne High School for 39 years. Sandi coached track, basketball, and cheerleading. She enjoyed reading, doing puzzles, mowing her lawn, and going to casinos. Sandi loved to travel and lived her life to the fullest.

She was a parishioner of St. John Paul II Catholic Church where she had also taught RCIA.
