



## Sandra Longtin

March 26, 1942 - June 8, 2019

Sandra Longtin, 77, of Kankakee, passed away Saturday (June 8, 2019) at her home, surrounded by family.

She was born March 26, 1942, in Kankakee, the daughter of Francis (Babe) and Edith Longtin.

Sandra was a graduate of St. Patrick High School (Bishop McNamara Catholic School) and later received her RN degree from the Holy Cross School of Nursing in South Bend, Ind. She pursued her nursing career at Passavant Hospital (Rush), in Chicago, and at Massachusetts General Hospital, in Boston, Mass., where she worked 10 years, primarily in the emergency room. Sandra returned to Illinois to further her education in nursing at Northern Illinois University in DeKalb, where she received her second degree in nursing. She worked at Barnes General Hospital in St. Louis and then returned to Kankakee, where she worked her final 40 years as a nurse at St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee, and at the Illinois Veterans Home at Manteno. After her retirement, Sandra served as a volunteer at the Riverside Medical Center gift shop in Kankakee.

Sandra was an active church member of St. John Paul II. She loved traveling, reading and visiting with her family.

"She truly was a special, caring person who sought to serve others," her family said.

Surviving are her brother, Roger (Katie) Longtin, of Illinois; her sister, Judy (Richard) Berdahl, of Indiana; her nephews and niece, Christopher Berdahl, of

Indiana, Timothy (Danielle) Berdahl, of Wisconsin, Jennifer (Andrew) Gillespie, of Colorado, Robert Longtin, of New York, and David Longtin, of Illinois; and her four great-nieces and great-nephews, Noah and Keiran Berdahl and Grace and Barra Gillespie.

Her parents preceded her in death.

Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday, June 11, at Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home in Kankakee. Funeral Mass will be at 9 a.m. Wednesday, June 12, at St. John Paul II, 953 S. Ninth Ave., Kankakee. Private inurnment will be in All Saints Cemetery in Bourbonnais.
