



## Sandra "Sandy" Reedy

October 28, 1941 - November 7, 2021

Sandra "Sandy" Reedy, age 80, of Bourbonnais passed away Sunday, November 7, 2021 at Bickford House of Bourbonnais. She was born October 28, 1941 in Pekin, IL, the daughter of Leland Keith & Laura (Parkhurst) Peck.

Sandy attended Olivet Nazarene University from 1959-1963, and returned to school to obtain her Registered Nurse degree at age 52 from Kankakee Community College. She worked as a nurse for 24 years, serving 19 of those years at Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee, where she retired at age 76.

Sandy was a long-time member of College Church of the Nazarene in Bourbonnais, and a life-time member of the Church of the Nazarene denomination.

Sandy was married to George Ide of Tampa, FL from 1963-1987, and then to David Reedy of Bourbonnais from 1989 to 1992, to whom she remained close friends until his death in 2015.

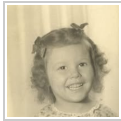
