She died Monday (Nov. 30, 2009) at Riverside Medical Center, Kankakee. Mrs. Dau had been a nurse for Drs. William and Tim Hodges, retiring in 2006 after 48 years of service. She was proud to state that she cared for three generations of families. She was born May 4, 1938, in Kankakee, the daughter of Frank and Luella Grob Fecke. She was a lifelong member of Grand Prairie United Methodist Church and a member of the Martha's Circle. She enjoyed quilting and her social group of quilting friends; traveling to Florida and Hawaii; and sports, especially watching the Illini. She loved her family and grandchildren and was looking forward to her first great-grandchild.
