Shirley J. Floyd, age 83, of Bourbonnais passed away Thursday, April 7, 2022 at St. Joseph Medical Center in Joliet. She was born September 30, 1938, the only child of Orville E. & Elsie F. (Sauberli) Heck. Shirley married William A. "Bill" Floyd on June 13, 1959 at First Evangelical United Brethren Church, now known as St. Mark United Methodist Church in Kankakee.
