Sieglinde A. "Linde" Boggess, 54, of Bourbonnais, passed away peacefully, surrounded by family and friends at her home Monday evening (July 28, 2008) after courageously battling ALS-Lou Gehrig's disease. Visitation will be from 3 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais, and from 9 a.m. Saturday at St. Paul Lutheran Church, Kankakee, until the 10 a.m. services. Burial will be in All Saints Cemetery, Bourbonnais. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to ALS-Lou Gehrig's disease or to Hospice of Kankakee Valley. Mrs. Boggess was a Realtor with Speckman Realty, where she had been a secretary 10 years prior to that. She was born Oct. 2, 1953, in Idar-Oberstein, Germany, the daughter of Paul and Elli Mueller Kuhn. She was an active member of St. Paul Lutheran Church, where she had formerly served on several boards. She was a member of the Kankakee Valley Garden Club, the Association of Realtors, and the National Association of Realtors. She enjoyed her grandchildren, reading and gardening. Surviving are her husband, Michael G. Boggess Sr., of Bourbonnais, whom she married July 30, 1971, in Idar-Oberstein; two sons and daughters-in-law, Michael Jr. and Kathy Boggess, Brian and Kris Boggess, all of Bourbonnais; five grandchildren, Brittany and Kayley LeClair, Sidney, Chase and Rhaina Boggess; her parents, Elli and Horst Willig of Idar-Oberstein; and two brothers, Siegfried Kuhn and Arnold Kuhn, both of Idar-Oberstein. 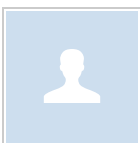
