



## Sr. Mary Of The Rosary McGuire SSCM

March 25, 1912 - December 11, 2009

Sister Mary Josephine "Sister Mary of the Rosary" McGuire, SSCM, 97, of Kankakee, died Friday (Dec. 11, 2009) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. Sunday at Provena St. Mary's Chapel in Kankakee, where a funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Monday. Burial will be in St. Mary's Cemetery, Beaverville. Memorials may be made to the Ministry Fund of the Servants of the Holy Heart of Mary. Sister McGuire was born March 25, 1912, in Chicago, the daughter of Francis and Mary Ann Conaghan McGuire. She made her first profession in 1954 and her perpetual vows in 1959. She attended St. Mary's High School in Chicago, later transferring to Holy Family Academy in Beaverville. She received her bachelor's degree in nursing arts from St. Louis University in Missouri. Upon graduation from college, Sister Mary of the Rosary served at St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee for almost all of her religious life in capacities such as X-ray technologist and instructor, community librarian and patient instructor. She spent many years in the nuclear medicine department at St. Mary's. Sister also served in the Rockford Diocese at St. Anne Center as a volunteer receptionist from 1985-1992. Upon her return to Kankakee in 1992, Sister Mary of the Rosary retired and resided in St. Mary Community (Delaplace) on the Provena St. Mary's campus, where she enjoyed spending her time reading, doing arts and crafts and most importantly, praying. Surviving are two sisters, Anne Ferguson and Kathleen Landeck; and many nieces and nephews. Deceased are her parents and one brother, Frank McGuire Jr.
