



Dr. Stanley D. Brezinski

December 18, 1923 - July 6, 2012

Dr. Stanley D. Brezinski, 88, of Kankakee, formerly of Park Ridge, died Friday (July 6, 2012) at the Miller Center in Kankakee. Cremation rites have been accorded. A memorial visitation will be held from 9 a.m. Wednesday until the 11 a.m. memorial service at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. The Rev. Linda Harris-Cosby will officiate.

Private inurnment will be held at a later date in Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery in Elwood. Memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley or to the Kankakee Valley Symphony Orchestra Association.

He was born Dec. 18, 1923, in Chicago, the son of Francis and Mary Ortowski Brzezinski. He married the former Sabina Czerchowicz on June 29, 1952. She preceded him in death April 19, 2010. Dr. Brezinski earned his bachelor's degree from Loyola University Chicago and also his DDS from Loyola University Chicago School of Dentistry in 1947. He was on faculty at Loyola University from 1947 to 1949 and was past president of the Northwest Side Branch of the Chicago Dental Society. He retired in 1985 from his private practice in Park Ridge. Dr. Brezinski served in the U.S. Army from Dec. 14, 1942 to Sept. 14, 1944; ordered to active duty with the U.S. Navy on May 20, 1949; ordered to Fleet Marine Force on July 28, 1950 and reported on Aug. 3, 1950 to the 1st Marine Division, Camp Joseph Pendleton, Oceanside, Calif.; participated in the Marine Amphibious Assault and seizure of Inchon, Korea

on Sept. 15, 1950; departed Korean Combat Zone on May 20, 1951; and was released to inactive duty in the U.S. Naval Reserve on Dec. 7, 1951. He enjoyed fishing and bowling.

Surviving are two sons and daughters-in-law, Dr. Thomas E. and Ann L. Brezinski, of Bourbonnais, and John and Nancy Brezinski, of Grayslake; one daughter, Barbara Flynn, of Summitt, N.J.; five grandchildren, Edward and Elizabeth Flynn, Glenn and Anna Brezinski and Katharine Brezinski; and one sister-in-law, Terry Brzezinski, of Niles.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one brother, Dr. Frank Brzezinski; and one brother that died in infancy.
