He was a member of the Polish National Alliance, past member and grand knight of the Knights of Columbus in Kankakee, a member of the Polish Roman Catholic National Alliance, the Bourbonnais Sportsman's Club and past president of Club Hyzne in Chicago. He lived in France for 20 years. Surviving are one sister, Suzanne Savli of France; sister-in-law, Gertrude; one niece, Chantilly Spalan of Chicago; four nephews, John and Joe Spalan, both of Chicago, Walter and Patrick Savli, both of France; and dear friend, Alexandra Sowa of Chicago. One brother, John, is deceased.
