



Stephen Denoyer

March 3, 1955 - July 19, 2015

The world lost a much loved father, grandfather, brother and son. Stephen J. Denoyer, 60, of Bradley, who passed away peacefully at his home on Sunday (July 19, 2015), surrounded by his family. He had bravely confronted and fought a two-year battle with cancer.

Steve was born in Kankakee on March 3, 1955, the son of Ferdinand "Buck" and Gail (Hayes) Denoyer.

He was a member of the Kankakee Eastridge High School graduating class of 1973. He retired from the Bourbonnais Post Office in 2009, where he welcomed customers with a smile every day and earned the nickname Postal Steve. 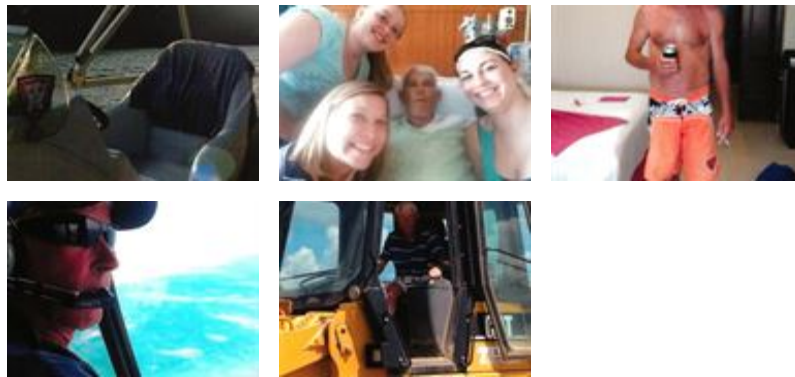

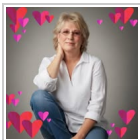
