Surviving are his wife, the former Mary J. Boudreau, whom he married Aug. 26, 1967, at St. Teresa Catholic Church, Kankakee; one son and daughter-in-law, Jason and Vicki Stankewicz of Bourbonnais; one daughter, Jamie Nicole Stankewicz of Naperville; two sisters and brothers-in-law, Marita and Scott Smith of Lombard, Lisa and Mike Polk of Park Ridge; three brothers and one sister-in-law, Melvin and Joyce Stankewicz of Janesville, Wis., Randy Stankewicz and his friend, Setta of Phoenix, Ariz., Kevin Stankewicz of Chicago; and one granddaughter, Abigale. He was a 1965 graduate of Bishop McNamara High School. He received a bachelor of science degree from Lewis University and a master's in business administration from Olivet Nazarene University. 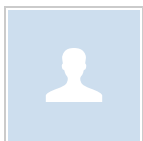
