



## Sue Ann McNabb

July 9, 1946 - September 3, 2014

Sue Ann McNabb, 68, of Kankakee, passed away Sept. 3, 2014 at Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee.

Sue was born on July 9, 1946, in Morris, the oldest of eight children born to Doris and Jack McNabb.

Surviving are her mother; sisters, Amie (Michael) Chaney, Mary (Mark) Davidson and Julie McNabb, all of Morris; brothers, John (Pam) McNabb and Tom (Jamie) McNabb, also of Morris; and many nieces and nephews.

Preceding her in death were her father; and two brothers, Richard and Michael McNabb.

Sue graduated from Morris Community High School in 1964 and Illinois State University, went on to teach at Gardner-South Wilmington High School and then went into business as the owner and operator of Women's World Fitness Center in Kankakee.

Cremation rites have been accorded. There will be no visitation. A funeral Mass will be at 10 a.m. Saturday at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church in Kankakee, with the Rev. Charles Wheeler and the Rev. Bob Duda officiating. Funeral arrangements are being handled by Clancy-Gernon Funeral Homes.

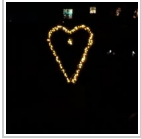
