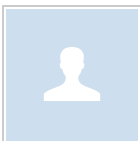

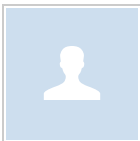
Good night gentle warrior, with laurel round your head, and battles done. i½i½With love you crushed your enemy, and wars you finally won.
