Sylvia C. Guimond, 100, of Bourbonnais, passed away Thursday (April 23, 2015) at her daughter's home in Plainfield.

She was born Nov. 11, 1914, in Irwin, the daughter of Ferdinand and Eva Trombley Denoyer. Sylvia married Armand J. Guimond on Feb. 1, 1932, at St. Rose Catholic Church in Kankakee.

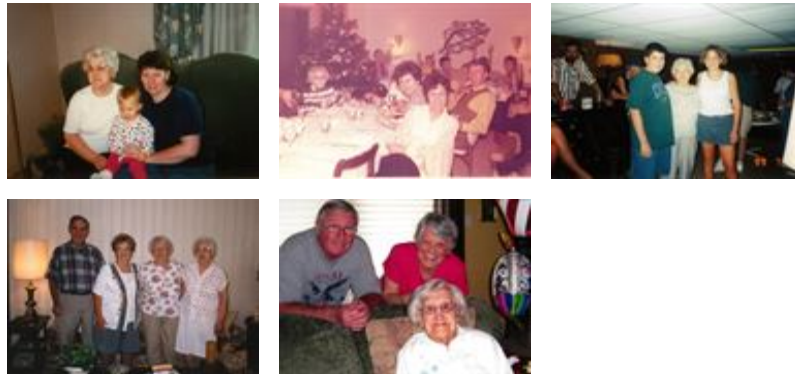
